Fixed

Fire record display improvements

Resolved issues affecting how active and reported fire records were displayed across maps and data tables. Agency fire IDs now retain their original formatting for greater accuracy and consistency.

Before fix some fire agency IDs were being treated as comma separated numbers:

Shaded Relief basemap restored

Fixed an issue that prevented the Shaded Relief basemap from displaying in the Interactive Maps.

Map export improvements

Resolved issues affecting map exports, including:

- Ensuring legends display correctly when opening an export preview.
- Improving consistency between the default export quality and the quality shown in the export options.

Improved

Added support for center and zoom URL parameters on the interactive maps URL

Interactive Maps now support additional URL parameters that allow you to share links focused on a specific area and map configuration.

You can create links that automatically:

- Open to a specific location.
- Use a predefined zoom level.
- Display selected map layers.
- Show a specific date.

This makes it easier to share map views for locations of interest such as provinces, regions, or individual incidents.

For example: https://cwfis.cfs.nrcan.gc.ca/en/interactive-map?selectedDate=¢er=-66.5_45.8&zoom=8.65&layerIds=public%3Am3polygons

- **center** specifies the map center as longitude_latitude
- **zoom** specifies the map zoom level
- **layerIds** controls which layer(s) are displayed
- **selectedDate** specifies the date to display (or can be omitted to use the current date)

Home page map updates

Based on user feedback, we have updated the order of maps in the home page carousel to make frequently used maps easier to access.

French language improvements

As part of an ongoing review of French content across the website, several language and translation updates have been made. Additional improvements will continue to be released over time.

Maintenance and reliability

To improve overall performance and stability, we have:

- Updated application components and supporting libraries.
- Improved map service integration and removed unsupported requests.

- Continued expanding automated testing coverage to help identify issues earlier and improve reliability.

This release includes a number of fixes and maintenance updates designed to improve the overall user experience, reliability, and quality of the website.
